

The Reza Ali Khazeni Memorial Scholarship for Graduate Study Abroad

The Reza Ali Khazeni Memorial Foundation is pleased to announce the availability of a study abroad scholarship for graduate students in Humanities, Fine Arts, Architecture, and Social & Behavioral Science. It will provide up to \$4,000.00 in support of graduate student research and study abroad.

The scholarship is intended for those who have **not traveled abroad** and who would not be able to engage in such travel without the scholarship. The scholarship is not intended for return to a student's home country, or North America, excepting Mexico.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be enrolled in a graduate program in the College of Humanities, College of Fine Arts, Graduate School of Architecture, or the College of Social & Behavioral Science at the University of Utah.
- The proposed study abroad experience must be approved by the applicant's graduate committee chair.
- The study abroad experience must be a minimum of six weeks in length.
- Maximum age 30 years old.
- The successful applicant is required to submit a written report of their travel and research to the Foundation.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants are required to complete the following for consideration:

- A one to two page statement outlining personal and professional background.
- A letter of acceptance from the Institution where you are going to study or do research and a description of proposed study abroad experience and how it relates to the applicant's graduate studies.
- A letter of reference from each of the following:
 - The Chair of the applicant's Graduate Committee
 - One other faculty member
- A personal curriculum vitae
- An updated official transcript.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

In accepting the scholarship, the recipient agrees to submit a brief report describing the goals of the study abroad experience and how they were achieved. In addition, the recipient must also submit a copy of the return airline ticket.
